
LEC 2017 Made for More Slideshow--Send Your Pictures

This expanded policy sets forth 'best practices' in the use of social media in the early childhood setting to protect children and parents' rights as well as the integrity of the center itself. Portions of the statement reflect recent changes in California Licensing regulations and interpretations regarding teachers' use of cell phones in the classroom as a 'lack of appropriate supervision'.
