California Private School Affidavit: Deadline is October 15

The legal window for the annual filing of the California private school affidavit is open now and extends through **October 15**. Section 33190 of the California Education Code requires every private school in the state to file this important document. Click here to file the online affidavit form. You should have received an email from the California Department of Education containing the password and filing instructions. This email was sent to all private schools in the Department's current database, meaning all schools that filed an affidavit last year. CAPE Update: Blue Ribbon Schools Named

U.S. Secretary of Education Betsy DeVos recently announced the names of schools identified by the U.S. Department of Education as the National Blue Ribbon Schools for 2017

Schools were selected either because their test scores in reading and math placed them among the top-performing schools in the nation or state, or because they made notable improvements in closing achievement gaps.

Fifty private schools were among the awardees this year. Each state's commissioner of education nominates public schools for the award, and CAPE nominates private schools. All winning schools will be honored at an awards ceremony November 6-7 in Washington, DC. <u>Click here</u> for the list of schools.
